Today, when you think of a CAD, you probably think of a computer application that helps architects, engineers, and other designers produce three-dimensional models of physical designs, such as building plans and detailed architectural drawings. While that's the primary use for CAD systems, many users also use them for drafting and documenting two-dimensional (2D) drawings such as blueprints and schematics. The first commercially available CAD system was designed by Ray Ozzie, a software engineer who worked for Paul Ricard and Aco Systems. He received a patent for the system in 1979. The program was introduced to the market in 1981, and in 1983, Ozzie formed a partnership with William Stallworth of Oregon Trail Systems (OTS), who owned the rights to the original CAD program and was interested in licensing the technology. Ozzie and Stallworth formed the AutoCAD Corporation in December 1983, and AutoCAD 1.0 was introduced in December 1984. AutoCAD 1.0 was a comprehensive CAD program that included both 2D and 3D applications. Ozzie and Stallworth had each contributed \$50,000 to the new company, and they brought in the rest of the funding by selling the rights to AutoCAD to other software companies. The early versions of AutoCAD included specialized 2D tools for drafting 2D architectural and engineering drawings and for drafting full-scale architectural models. AutoCAD was also the first commercially available CAD application to use the x, y, and z axes as a coordinate system. Users placed a drawing on a work plane that was always located at the origin (0,0) of the coordinate system. The x-axis points from the left to the right, the y-axis points up from the work plane to the sky, and the z-axis points down from the sky to the work plane. The x, y, and z values of a location in the drawing can then be used to locate and identify points on the drawing, as well as to show distances from points in the drawing to other points. AutoCAD was licensed to many different companies and became the flagship product of Autodesk, Inc. in 2002. The company is now based in San Rafael, California. AutoCAD has become one of the most popular CAD systems available today. History AutoCAD has changed over the years. A version of the application first released in December 1984 is called AutoCAD 1.0

Another calcium phosphate, calcium pyrophosphate, has also been examined as a possible implant for use in bone repair. A variety of calcium phosphate-based materials have been developed that have various physical and chemical properties that can be tailored to the desired application. Hydroxyapatite (HA) is the main mineral component of bone and tooth enamel. It is the most widely studied and used bioceramic. To date, it is the only calcium phosphate having the potential to surpass the properties of synthetic, non-biological calcium phosphates in all the applications where it has been used.
